CATHOLICISM SERIES comes to Sacred Heart this Lent

Most of us know Fr. Bob Barron; for nearly ten years he was one of the weekend presiders and preachers at Sacred Heart. In fact, it was during this time that Fr. Barron began “Word on Fire” and the people of Sacred Heart contributed in support of his evangelization efforts on the internet.

Today Fr. Barron is widely known as the writer, host and narrator of the CATHOLICISM series, a video series which has recently been released.

Since this fall the series has gone viral. Four of the episodes were aired in Chicago’s WTTW, receiving very high ratings, and EWTN is airing the other six episodes. To date, there have been over 1,000 broadcasts on public television stations – in more than 100 markets! George Weigel, internationally known author and syndicated columnist, has called this series “The Most Important Media Project in the History of the Catholic Church in America.”

During Lent, we are pleased to announce that Fr. Barron’s CATHOLICISM series will come to Sacred Heart. I have asked **Nancy Ross and Mike Leonard** (Producer and Executive Producer of the series) to help us choose a theme for each week’s Lenten Gospel and then match series’ segments to the theme and the Sunday Gospels. These themes will also be the focus of our Sunday homilies. We will offer parishioners the opportunity to join home-based discussion groups where the Lenten Gospels will be read and the parallel CATHOLICISM segments shown. These discussions will be about an hour and fifteen or twenty minutes and will end with a brief prayer. Anyone interested in being involved in any way, please feel free to contact me.

The series also has a serious and detailed study guide which extends for 11 weeks. If the Lenten Prayer – Discussion series is successful and folks are interested, we could offer the complete series in the fall.

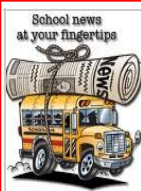

SCHOOL NEWS!

Registration for the 2012-2013 school year has begun. If you have a child who will be 4 by Sept. 1, 2012, whom you wish to enroll in our extended day JK program, or have a child who will be 5 by Sept. 1, 2012, whom you wish to enroll in Kindergarten, you will need to fill out a registration form and include a \$600 non refundable fee. All NEW students require a registration form, Baptismal Certificate, and Birth Certificate. If your child is already in JK and will just be moving on to Kindergarten, there is a RE-registration form to fill out, and you will be guaranteed a spot in Kindergarten. JK and NEW Kindergarten spots are first come, first served so don't delay in turning in your registration form as space is limited and fills up quickly. If you have any questions, please contact the office.

SHS students participated in a food drive for Marillac House, a social services organization that serves underprivileged families in the city of Chicago. The students collected enough food for an entire turkey dinner, complete with all the side dishes and desert, for over 100 families. Thank you all who donated food items and your time to deliver the food to Marillac House. The families thank you too.

Several students also helped prepare snack bags and containers with daily essentials for those in need at the PADS Family Center. All the items donated were purchased with funds from Chloes-crew.org, the organization in honor of Chloe, a Sacred Heart student who died of a brain tumor in March 2010. Thanks to all who participated.

The entire school participated in the Shedd Aquarium's "Wreath-Cycle" challenge. Each grade level combined their talents to create a wreath that was made entirely of recyclable materials. The students found wreath materials in their classrooms and homes and came up with some incredibly creative projects! There were 119 wreaths submitted by Chicago area schools. The wreaths were submitted to the Shedd for judging and two of our wreaths made the final 25! Kindergarten and Student Council were voted on for the "fan favorite" through Facebook. The winning class will receive a free field trip to the Shedd!

Tuesday, January 10th, the 8th graders will have their graduation pictures taken. They may be out of uniform in nice dress clothes, boys in tie and jacket, and girls in nice tops or dresses.
